

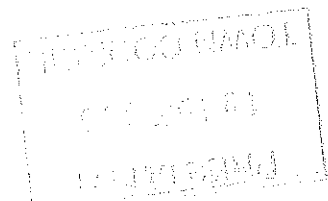

Background

Prestatyn Town Council successfully applied and obtained Business in the Community, Healthy High Streets status in 2014. The programme involves the integration of national and local businesses to support each other to help regenerate town centres. Within the programme there are key performance measurement criteria including reduction of empty shops, increased employment, increased footfall and promotion of civic pride.

For many years Town Council and local businesses have requested Denbighshire County Council to consider the introduction of free car parking in order to attract High Street customers and visitors but without success.

Town Council has a long history of providing temporary free car parks in partnership with others, reviving poor car parks, and development of award winning secure car park status at Top Central Car Park, Lower Railway Station and most recently Fern Avenue car park.

a) Fern Avenue Car Park

The County owned site suffered from poor signage and low use and Town Council managed to negotiate a rental charge with Denbighshire County Council for use of Fern Avenue car park to enable introduction of four hours free car parking at top of High Street. The result has been dramatic with much higher levels of usage, boost to local retailers, and opportunities to enable town centre events to be hosted at top of town.

b) Ty Nant Site Car Park

The large Ty Nant site car park is currently underused and generates very little income for its owner Denbighshire County Council. The County has vacated staff from most of the Ty Nant site and declared it surplus to requirements, they are also inviting expressions of interest from potential developers for whole of site, and carrying out a public consultation exercise about its future.

Town Council would like to introduce temporary free day visitor car parking and has obtained support from many parties including Healthy High Streets, local retailers and County Member Area Group

Future Plans

Ty Nant site and Fern Avenue are considered key elements for increasing footfall to Prestatyn High Street via introduction of free car parking. The proposed plans for introducing day visitor free car parking will also provide creative marketing opportunities to enable High Street businesses to compete with newly developed retail park and other towns.

Both car parks are owned by Denbighshire County Council (DCC) and protracted negotiations have taken place as County have concerns about strategic impact of free car parking on other Denbighshire car parks and other towns. It should be noted that DCC King's Avenue short stay car park will remain pay and display as Town Council recognises the importance for short stay at this smaller short stay car park. Similarly DCC Offa's Tavern and Lower Railway Station car parks will remain pay and display.

Denbighshire County Council's historical approach involved managing car parks as a traffic management operation and latterly as income generator. It is only recently that the broader impact and role of car parks within the economy has been acknowledged e.g. footfall generators, new and established business incentive, and positive impact on tourism. Although each town is different DCC has sought and continues to apply a strategic County approach to its car park operations so Town Council's approach has been carefully scrutinised, assessed and monitored.

Proposals

It is recommended that Town Council enters a twelve month 12.5k agreement with Denbighshire County Council for introduction of free day visitor car parking at Ty Nant site and Fern Avenue car parks. This agreement will also provide opportunity for Town Council to secure additional external funding to contribute to introduction of signage and information points to improve town visitor experience.

The County have requested a number of income safeguards, monitoring and three month termination notice by either party which can be accommodated within the agreement.
